**Tones And I remains at #1 with 'Dance Monkey' for fifth week**

**Taylor Swift scores biggest week for any album in 2019**

**Taylor Swift invades the Single Chart with thirteen entries in the Top 50**

### Singles Highlights

**#1: Tones And I 'Dance Monkey'** – For the fifth consecutive week, Tones And I is at #1 on the ARIA Singles Chart with 'Dance Monkey'. The last time an Australian female solo artist spent five weeks at #1 was when Gabriella Cilmi's 'Sweet About Me' held the top spot for five non-consecutive weeks in May/June 2008. The most time spent at #1 by an Australian female solo artist was Kylie Minogue with 'Locomotion' (#1 Aug '87). This week, Tones And I released her debut EP, *The Kids Are Coming*; look out for it on next week's chart.

**#3: Taylor Swift 'Lover'** – Debuting at #1 on this week's Albums Chart with *Lover*, Taylor Swift scores 13 entries on the Singles Chart this week with tracks from her seventh album. After debuting at #15 last week, *Lover's* title track has moved up 12 spots to become the album's third Top Three single after 'Me!' (#2 May '19) and 'You Need To Calm Down' (#3 Jun. '19).

**#7: Marshmello Feat. Kane Brown 'One Thing Right'** – Hitting its ninth week in the chart, Marshmello's 'One Thing Right' moves up two spots to claim another new peak at #7.

**#17: Taylor Swift 'The Man'** – There are nine debuts by Taylor Swift on this week's Singles Chart. At #17, 'The Man' is the highest new entry from this week's #1 album, *Lover*. She's also debuted with 'Cruel Summer' (#22), 'I Forgot That You Existed' (#24), 'Paper Rings' (#29), 'Miss Americana & The Heartbreak Prince' (#32), 'I Think He Knows' (#34), 'Cornelia Street' (#40), 'London Boy' (#42) and 'Death By A Thousand Cuts' (#48).

**#30: 5 Seconds Of Summer 'Teeth'** – 5 Seconds Of Summer score their third chart entry for the year with 'Easier'. The second track to come from the Sydney group's forthcoming fourth album also appears on the third season

### Albums Highlights

**#1: Taylor Swift 'Lover'** – American superstar Taylor Swift scores her fifth #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart with her seventh studio album *Lover*. It is the single biggest week for any album in 2019. Taylor also looks likely to be the artist with the most #1 albums this decade with 5. She has also previously hit #1 with *Speak Now* (#1 Nov. '10), *Red* (#1 Oct. '12), *1989* (#1 Nov. '14) and *Reputation* (#1 Nov. '17). 13 of the album's 18 tracks are in the Top 50 of this week's ARIA Singles Chart.

**#3: Brockhampton 'Ginger'** – American collective Brockhampton grab their highest charts peak with new album, *Ginger*. The fifth studio album by the 13-member hip-hop group becomes their second Top Ten entry after *Iridescence* (#6 Oct. '18).

**#10: Tropical F\*\*k Storm 'Braindrops'** – Melbourne quartet Tropical F\*\*k Storm net their second chart appearance in as many years and their first Top Ten entry with *Braindrops*. Featuring Gareth Liddiard and Fiona Kitschin from The Drones, the band's second album comes just over a year on from their debut, *A Laughing Death in Meatspace* (#25 May '18). *Braindrops* is #1 on the ARIA Vinyl Albums Chart this week.

**#11: Waax 'Big Grief'** – Brisbane's Waax make their chart debut with *Big Grief*. The quintet's debut album was co-produced by Bernard Fanning and Nick DiDia. Prior to the album, Waax released two EPs: *Holy Sick* (2015) and *Wild & Weak* (2017). *Big Grief* hits the Vinyl Albums Chart at #2.

**#24: Winterbourne 'Echo Of Youth'** – Australian duo Winterbourne release their debut album, *Echo Of Youth*. It's the second time the act - made up of James Draper and Jordan Brady - have appeared in the ARIA Top 50: their second EP, *Pendulum*, peaked at #23 in June 2016.
