



**On this week's ARIA Charts:  
Ed Sheeran shatters ARIA Chart records, and dominates with 16 of  
the top 40 singles, 'Shape Of You' at No. 1 for ninth week,  
'÷' debuts at the top of the albums chart**

**Singles Chartifacts:**

**#1: Ed Sheeran 'Shape Of You'** – For a ninth consecutive week, Ed Sheeran sits at #1 on the ARIA Singles Chart with 'Shape Of You'. Ed Sheeran also appears another fifteen times in this week's ARIA Top 50 Singles Chart with 'Castle On The Hill' at #2, 'Dive' at #5, 'Perfect' at #6, 'Galway Girl' at #10, 'How Would You Feel (Paeon)' at #13, 'Happier' at #16, 'Supermarket Flowers' at #19, 'New Man' at #20, 'What Do I Know?' at #24, 'Eraser' at #31, 'Heart Don't Break Around Here' at #32, 'Barcelona' at #36, 'Nancy Mulligan' at #37, 'Save Myself' at #38, and 'Bibia Be Ye Ye' at #39. With 16 songs charting simultaneously in the top 40, Sheeran sets a new ARIA Charts milestone with the most ever by a single artist. Also, no living act has had more than 14 singles in the top 100 at any given time – Ed has 18 this week.

**#4: Lorde 'Green Light' (Debut)** - 'Green Light' is a song by New Zealand singer and songwriter Lorde. It is the lead single from her upcoming second studio album 'Melodrama'.

**#9: Zedd Feat. Alessia Cara 'Stay'** – In its second week in the top 50, 'Stay' by Zedd featuring Alessia Cara jumps up 7 places to claim a new peak at #9.

**#14: Bruno Mars 'That's What I Like'** – In its third week in the top 50 Bruno Mars' 'That's What I Like' continues its climb up the ARIA Singles Chart.

### Albums Chartifacts:

**#1: Ed Sheeran '÷' (Debut)** – ÷ (pronounced "divide") is the third studio album by English singer-songwriter Ed Sheeran and the third to reach #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart. He previously topped the chart with '+' (#1 Aug. '12) which this week sits at #4 and 'x' (#1 Jun. '14) which this week sits at #3.

**#8: All Our Exes Live in Texas 'When We Fall' (Debut)** – Australian folk group All Our Exes Live in Texas make their first appearance on ARIA Album Chart with their debut album 'When We Fall'.

**#10: Kingswood 'After Hours, Close To Dawn' (Debut)** – Album number two for Melbourne rock band Kingswood. The band have previously charted with 'Microscopic Wars' (#6 Sept. '14).

**#16: Methyl Ethel 'Everything Is Forgotten' (Debut)** – Perth trio Methyl Ethel make their top 50 ARIA Album Chart debut with their second album 'Everything Is Forgotten'.

**#18: Justin Bieber 'Purpose'** - With Justin Bieber's Australian tour up and running, his #1 charting album 'Purpose' (#1 Nov. '15) jumps back into the Top 50 ARIA Albums Chart for a 49<sup>th</sup> week.
