Justin Bieber holds at Number One as Perth's Troye Sivan hits the top on debut with new album 'Wild' – on this week's ARIA charts

Singles Chartifacts:

#1: Justin Bieber 'What Do You Mean?' – Week two at the top of the ARIA Singles Chart for Justin Bieber's 'What Do You Mean?' Since debuting in the top spot last week, it has since topped charts in the UK, US, Canada and more.

#2: Macklemore & Ryan Lewis Feat. Eric Nally, Melle Mel, Kool Moe Dee & Grandmaster Caz 'Downtown' – A jump of seven spots for 'Downtown' in its second week on the chart.

#14: Sigala 'Easy Love' (debut) – British DJ/producer Sigala makes his first appearance on the ARIA Singles Chart with 'Easy Love'. The track samples 'ABC' by The Jackson 5.

#37: Reigan 'Feels Like Heaven' (debut) – The third Singles Chart appearance and first for 2015 for former *X Factor* contestant Reigan. 'Feels Like Heaven' is the first single to come from her forthcoming album. She last charted with 'All Of The Pieces' (#33 Dec. '14).

#49: N.W.A 'Fk Tha Police' (debut)** – The N.W.A chart juggernaut isn't just confined to the Albums Chart. This marks the first time 'F**k Tha Police' has charted in Australia. The only N.W.A release to previously chart in the top 50 on the Singles Chart was the EP '100 Miles And Running' (#33 Jan. '91).

Albums Chartifacts:

#1: Troye Sivan 'Wild' (debut) – Perth singer-songwriter Troye Sivan blasts straight into #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart with his debut album, 'Wild'. It is his first appearance on the Albums Chart. He previously peaked at #10 on the Singles Chart in August 2014 with 'Happy Little Pill'. The album's title track has debuted on this week's Singles Chart at #16. The 'Wild' album has also debuted at #5 in the UK and #3 in NZ.

'Wild' is the seventh Australian #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart in 2015.

#2: Iron Maiden 'The Book Of Souls' (debut) – British metal legends Iron Maiden pick up their second #2 album in a row with 'The Book Of Souls'. It's the band's 16th studio album and first in five years. They last charted with 'The Final Frontier' (#2 Aug. '10). Iron Maiden will be touring Australia sometime in 2016.

#3: Five Finger Death Punch 'Got Your Six' (debut) – Album six from Five Finger Death Punch gives the Las Vegas metal band their highest peak on the ARIA Charts. 'Got Your Six' is the band's fourth top 50 appearance. Their previous best was with 'The Wrong Side Of Heaven And The Righteous Side Of Hell, Volume 1' (#13 Aug. '13).

#8 & #9: N.W.A 'Straight Outta Compton' & 'Greatest Hits' – Following on from the release of the biopic *Straight Outta Compton* last week, N.W.A make their first ever top ten appearance on the ARIA Albums Chart with not one, but two albums. Prior to the recent resurgence in interest in the group, 'Straight Outta Compton' peaked at #51 in July 1990 and 'Greatest Hits' peaked at #64 in September 1996. Another compilation, 'The Strength Of Street Knowledge: The Best Of N.W.A.', debuts at #33 this week.

#12: Vance Joy 'Dream Your Life Away' – A sharp jump back up the chart for Vance Joy's debut album, following the release of a two-disc deluxe edition. The re-release includes the new single 'Fire And The Flood' (#6 Sept. '15) as well as a number of new and live tracks. 'Dream Your Life Away' debuted at #1 when it was released in September 2014.
