Australian artists claim No. 1 on this week's ARIA Singles and Albums Charts: Sheppard and Chet Faker triumph

5 Aussies in singles chart top 10, 7 in albums chart top 10

Singles:

Top 5:

1. Sheppard 'Geronimo'

Singles Chartifacts:

#1: Sheppard 'Geronimo' – Having picked up their first #1 on the ARIA Charts last week with 'Geronimo', Brisbane's Sheppard retain the top spot for a second week.

#3: Sia 'Chandelier' – In its third week in the top ten, a jump of two spots puts 'Chandelier' within striking distance of the coveted #1 position.

#6: Jessica Mauboy 'Never Be The Same' – 'Never Be The Same' moves up from #17 to give Jessica Mauboy her seventh top ten on the ARIA Singles Chart. It's also her second top ten to come from the album 'Beautiful' (#3 Oct. '13) after 'Pop A Bottle (Fill Me Up)' (#2 Oct. '13).

#15: Justin Timberlake 'Not A Bad Thing' – Now in its third week in the top 50, 'Not A Bad Thing' continues its steady climb up the chart. It's the first top 50 single to come from Timberlake's 'The 20/20 Experience - 2 Of 2' (#4 Oct. '13).

#18: Samantha Jade 'Up!' – 'Up!' is the third single to be released from Samantha Jade's forthcoming second studio album. It also becomes the third single from the album to hit the top 20, following Fire Starter (#9 Jul. '13) and Soldier (#17 Nov. '13).

Albums Chartifacts:

#1: Chet Faker 'Built On Glass' (debut) – The debut album from Chet Faker has earned the Melbourne electronic artist his first #1 on the ARIA Charts. 'Built On Glass' is the second appearance on the Albums Chart for Faker (real name Nicholas Murphy); his EP 'Thinking In Textures' debuted in April 2012 and peaked at #38 last week. One track from the album has already hit the top 50 on the Singles Chart: 'Talk Is Cheap' (#34 Feb. '12). 'Built On Glass' is the third album by an Australian act to top the ARIA Albums Chart so far in 2014.

#4: Russell Morris 'Van Diemen's Land' (debut) – After picking up his first ever top ten on the ARIA Charts last year with the ARIA Award-winning 'Sharkmouth' (#6 Apr. '13), Russell Morris picks up his highest peak to date with the follow-up album 'Van Diemen's Land'. Like its predecessor, 'Van Diemen's Land' features a host of guests including Joe Camilleri, Vika and Linda Bull and Rick Springfield.

#5: Harrison Craig 'L.O.V.E.' (debut) – The second album from Melbourne singer Harrison Craig. It's the first post-*The Voice* album for the winner of the 2013 series. Craig's debut album, 'More Than A Dream', spent two non-consecutive weeks at #1 in July last year.

#13: Bliss N Eso 'Circus In The Sky' – A hefty jump back up the chart for the former #1 album on the back of the Sydney hip hop trio's current national tour.

#31: Black Label Society 'Catacombs Of The Black Vatican' (debut) – American heavy metal band's ninth studio album. It's their second album to chart in the ARIA top 50 following 'Order Of The Black' (#44 Aug. '10).
