**New number ones feature on this week's ARIA Charts:
Lil Nas X and BTS reach the peak for the first time, BTS create ARIA
chart history**

Singles Chartifacts:

#1: Lil Nas X 'Old Town Road' – 'Old Town Road' by American rapper Lil Nas X climbs to #1 on the ARIA Singles Chart. The track – which has spent two weeks at #1 in the US – hits the top spot in Australia in its fourth week in the Top 50. A remix of the song was recently released featuring Billy Ray Cyrus.

#4: Khalid 'Talk' – In its tenth week in the Top 50, Khalid's 'Talk' moves up one spot to claim a new peak at #4.

#10: BTS Feat. Halsey 'Boy With Luv' (Debut) – As well as debuting at #1 on this week's Albums Chart, BTS hit the Singles Chart with 'Boy With Luv'. Featuring American artist Halsey, the track is the fourth to appear in the Top 50 for the Korean pop stars and a new peak. Their previous best was with 'Idol' (#35 Sept. '18).

#11: Avicii Feat. Aloe Blacc 'SOS' (Debut) – The late Swedish producer Avicii features on this week's Singles Chart with the Aloe Blacc-featured single 'SOS'. The track is the first to be released from the forthcoming posthumous album, *Tim*, which is set for release in June. Aloe Blacc previous collaborated with Avicii on the single 'Wake Me Up' (#1 Jul. '13).

#13: Lewis Capaldi 'Someone You Loved' – Moving up six spots, Lewis Capaldi's 'Someone You Loved' secures a new peak at #13 in its fourth week on the chart.

Albums Chartifacts:

#1: BTS 'Map Of The Soul: Persona' (Debut) – Korean pop juggernaut BTS land their first #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart with *Map Of The Soul: Persona*. The EP is the seven-member group's fourth Top Ten on the chart after *Love Yourself 承 'Her'* (#8 Sept. '17), *Love Yourself 轉 'Tear'* (#6 May '18) and *Love Yourself 結 'Answer'* (#9 Sept. '18). One track from the EP, the Halsey-featured 'Boy With Luv', has debuted on this week's Singles Chart at #10.

Map Of The Soul: Persona becomes the first release sung in an Asian language to hit #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart.

#4: The Seekers 'Farewell' (Debut) – 1995 ARIA Hall Of Fame inductees The Seekers release the live album, *Farewell*. Recorded in Melbourne in 2013 during the quartet's Golden Jubilee tour, it's their first chart entry since compilation album *The Golden Jubilee Album* (#10 Dec. '12).

#14: Norah Jones 'Begin Again' (Debut) – American singer-songwriter Norah Jones returns with her seventh studio album, *Begin Again*. The follow-up to *Day Breaks* (#4 Oct. '16) is also Jones' seventh release to hit the Top 50. Jones played a run of dates in the country this week before performing at Bluesfest over the Easter weekend. Jones' debut *Come Away With Me* spent nine weeks at #1 in 2003.

#17: The Chemical Brothers 'No Geography' (Debut) – The Chemical Brothers score a ninth ARIA Top 50 entry with *No Geography*. The British big beat duo's ninth studio album comes four years on from *Born In The Echoes* (#5 Jul. '15). They previously hit #1 with *Come With Us* (#1 Feb. '02).

#19: Anderson .Paak 'Ventura' (Debut) – Less than a year on from *Oxnard* (#20 Nov. '18), Anderson .Paak hits the chart again with *Ventura*. The album is the American rapper's fourth and features appearances by Smokey Robinson, Andre 3000, Brandy and more.
