



P!nk joined by Gang Of Youths at the top of this week's ARIA Charts:

'What About Us' holds at No.1 as 'Go Farther In Lightness' reaches the top on debut

4 Australian albums feature in this week's top 5!

Singles Chartifacts:

#1: P!nk 'What About Us' – P!nk holds the top spot on the ARIA Singles Chart for a second week with her ninth #1 single 'What About Us'.

#2: Justin Bieber & BloodPop® 'Friends' (debut) – Justin Bieber returns to the top entry as a lead artist for the first time since 2015 with 'Friends'. Bieber's eighth top ten single as a lead artist is a collaboration with American producer/songwriter BloodPop®. BloodPop® previously collaborated with Bieber on several songs on the album *Purpose* (#1 Nov. '15), including 'Sorry' (#2 Nov. '15).

#10: Dua Lipa 'New Rules' – After jumping five spots last week, 'New Rules' has moved up a further five spots this week to become Dua Lipa's second top ten on the ARIA Singles Chart. She first hit the top ten with 'Be The One' (#6 May '16).

#14: Demi Lovato 'Sorry Not Sorry' – In its sixth week in the top 50, 'Sorry Not Sorry' jumps up seven spots and becomes Demi Lovato's highest peak to date on the ARIA Singles Chart, taking over from 'Cool For The Summer' (#20 Aug. '15).





#44: Khalid 'Young Dumb & Broke' (debut) – American R&B artist Khalid takes out his second top 50 entry as a lead artist on the ARIA Singles Chart with 'Young Dumb & Broke'. Like previous single 'Location' (#39 Aug. '17), it comes from the 19 year old's debut album *American Teen* (#21 Aug. '17).

Albums Chartifacts:

#1: Gang Of Youths 'Go Farther In Lightness' (debut) – Sydney's Gang Of Youths score their debut #1 on the ARIA Charts with *Go Farther In Lightness*. The band's second album comes just over two years on from *The Positions* (#5 Apr. '15). In between albums, the five-piece released the EP *Let Me Be Clear* (#2 Aug. '16).

Go Farther In Lightness is the seventh Australian #1 album on the ARIA Charts in 2017.

#4: King Gizzard & The Lizard Wizard 'Sketches Of Brunswick East' (debut) – Melbourne's King Gizzard & The Lizard Wizard release their third studio album of 2017, *Sketches Of Brunswick East*. A collaboration with Californian artist Alex Brettin (aka Mild High Club), it's the follow-up to *Murder Of The Universe* (#3 Jul. '17) and *Flying Microtonal Banana* (#2 Mar. '17). King Gizzard & The Lizard plan on releasing two more albums before the end of the year.

#5: Thy Art Is Murder 'Dear Desolation' (debut) – With their fourth studio album, deathcore band Thy Art Is Murder hit the top ten on the ARIA Albums Chart for a second time. *Dear Desolation* is the Sydney band's follow-up to *Holy War* (#7 Jul. '15) and is their new chart peak. In 2016, they also charted with the split EP with American bands The Acacia Strain and Fit For An Autopsy, *The Depressions Sessions* (#38 Aug. '16).





#6: Brand New 'Science Fiction' (debut) – The fifth studio album for Brand New gives the New Jersey band their first top ten on the ARIA Albums Chart. *Science Fiction* is the band's first album since *Daisy* (#40 Oct. '09) eight years ago.

#8: Neck Deep 'The Peace And The Panic' (debut) – Welsh pop-punk band Neck Deep crack the top ten for the first time with third album *The Peace And The Panic*. It's the group's second album to chart in the top 50, following on from second album *Life's Not Out To Get You* (#28 Aug. '15).
