



## Post Malone leaps to Number One as The Killers score their second chart-topping album, on this week's ARIA Charts

### Singles Chartifacts:

**#1: Post Malone Feat. 21 Savage 'Rockstar'** – In its second week in the top 50, 'Rockstar' gives American rapper Post Malone his first #1 on the ARIA Singles Chart. Coming from Post Malone's forthcoming *Beerbongs And Bentleys* album, it debuted at #2 in the US.

**#5: Logic Feat. Alessia Cara & Khalid '1-800-273-8255'** – Logic's '1-800-273-8255' climbs up two more spots this week to hit the top five for the first time. In the US, the song has peaked to date at #3, passing Tommy Tutone's 1982 #4 '867-5309/Jenny' as the highest charting title featuring a phone number.

**#15: Portugal. The Man 'Feel It Still'** – Five weeks into its run in the top 50 'Feel It Still' moves up a further five spots to claim a new peak.

**#16: Camila Cabello Feat. Young Thug 'Havana'** – Moving up 18 in its fifth week in the top 50, 'Havana' becomes Camila Cabello's highest chart peak, taking over from her collaboration with Machine Gun Kelly 'Bad Things' (#22 Feb. '17).

**#25: Macklemore Feat. Kesha 'Good Old Days' (debut)** – In the week his second solo album *Gemini* has debuted at #3 on the ARIA Albums Chart, American rapper Macklemore takes out his second solo entry on the ARIA Singles Chart. Featuring Kesha, 'Good Old Days' follows 'Glorious' (#2 Aug. '17) into the chart.

### Albums Chartifacts:

**#1: The Killers 'Wonderful Wonderful' (debut)** – The first studio album in five years from The Killers gives the American band their second #1 on the ARIA Albums Chart. The Killers' fifth album, *Wonderful Wonderful* continues the group's top ten run that began with *Hot Fuss* (#1 Feb. '05) and continued with *Sam's Town* (#2 Oct. '06), *Day & Age* (#4 Dec. '08) and *Battle Born* (#2 Sept. '12). They also charted with the rarities compilation *Sawdust* (#6 Nov. '07). The Killers are the headline act at this year's AFL Grand Final.

**#3: Macklemore 'Gemini' (debut)** – American rapper Macklemore picks up his first solo appearance on the ARIA Albums Chart with *Gemini*. The album is Macklemore's second solo album; the first, *The Language Of My World*, was released in 2005. He's previously charted with two albums released with collaborator Ryan Lewis: *The Heist* (#2 Jan. '13) and *This Unruly Mess I've Made* (#6 Mar. '16). *Glorious* includes the singles 'Glorious' (#2 Aug. '17) and 'Good Old Days' (#25 Oct. '17). Macklemore performs at this weekend's NRL Grand Final.

**#11: Van Morrison 'Roll With The Punches' (debut)** – Illustrious singer-songwriter Van Morrison releases his 37th studio album *Roll With The Punches*. It becomes his third studio album in as many years to hit the ARIA top 50, following *Duets: Re-Working The Catalogue* (#10 Apr. '15) and *Keep Me Singing* (#11 Oct. '16). *Roll With The Punches* includes work with noted blues players Jeff Beck, Paul Jones and Georgie Fame.

**#12: British India 'Forgetting The Future' (debut)** – The sixth studio album from Melbourne's British India gives the four-piece a fifth top 50 entry on the ARIA Albums Chart. *Forgetting The Future* is the follow-up to *Nothing Touches Me* (#5 Mar. '15), the band's highest chart peak to date along with *Thieves* (#5 Jul. '08).





**#16: Midnight Oil 'Essential Oils: The Great Circle Gold Tour Edition'** – With their national reunion tour kicking off on 2 October, Midnight Oil re-enter the chart with this compilation, originally released in November 2012. When first released, it peaked at #7.
