'Rockabye' from Clean Bandit Feat. Sean Paul & Anne-Marie and Michael Buble's 'Christmas' album claim peak positions on this week's ARIA Charts

Singles Chartifacts:

#1: Clean Bandit Feat. Sean Paul & Anne-Marie 'Rockabye' – Week number 5 at the top spot for the Cambridge Electronic trio. Rockabye, which features input from Sean Paul and Anne-Marie and has now been certified Platinum.

#2: The Weeknd 'Starboy' – The Weeknd once again remains at #2 this week on the ARIA Singles Chart. At 11 weeks, the Canadian artist has now taken the record for most weeks spent at #2 without ever reaching number one on the ARIA Singles Chart. 'Starboy' has now succeeded in surpassing Maroon 5 & Christina Aguilera's 'Moves Like Jagger' (#2 Aug. '11).

#4: The Chainsmokers Feat. Halsey 'Closer'- After teetering on the outskirts of the top 10 in recent weeks, 'Closer' makes its return to the top 5. The Chainsmokers currently have three singles within the top 50, with 'All We Know' and 'Don't Let Me Down' hitting #37 and #46 this week respectively.

#9: Justin Timberlake 'Can't Stop The Feeling!' – With a move of 7 spots, 'Can't Stop The Feeling!' jumps back into the top 10 for a 14th week. The move comes thanks to the popularity of the animated feature film 'Trolls', which is currently in cinemas and features the single. The Soundtrack is currently at #6 again this week.

Albums Chartifacts:

#1: Michael Buble 'Christmas' – The king of Christmas has regained his spot atop the ARIA Albums chart this week. The Canadian crooner's 'Christmas' has hit #1 again to make it 14 weeks in total. With the exception of last year, Buble has held #1 position on or around every Christmas since the record's debut in 2011.

#11: George Michael 'Twenty Five' – With the untimely passing of English singer, songwriter, record producer and global pop icon George Michael, comes the album that celebrated Twenty 25 years of music and influence. 'Twenty Five' was Michael's second collection and originally peaked at #9 back in March 2010. Singles featured on the album include 'Faith' (#1 pre-ARIA) 'Careless Whisper' (#1 pre-ARIA) 'Don't Let The Sun Go Down On Me' (#3 Jan.'92) and more.

#14 George Michael 'Ladies & Gentlemen... The Best Of...' – As the tributes continue to flow for the legendary singer, so do the albums and singles that helped make his name. 'Ladies & Gentlemen... The Best Of...' re-enters the chart this week at #14. The first compilation album from the Post-disco titan includes hits spanning his career from 'Careless Whisper' (this week at #64) to 'Faith' (#50 this week) and 'Don't Let The Sun Go Down On Me' (#93 this week).
