**Justin Timberlake returns to the ARIA Album Chart with a number one debut!**

**Macklemore & Ryan Lewis join esteemed company with their third No. 1 on the ARIA Singles Chart**

## Singles

**#1: Macklemore & Ryan Lewis featuring Ray Dalton 'Can't Hold Us'** - This is the third Australian number one for this duo just 17 weeks after they first reached the summit. Only two acts in the past 50 years have reached the chart peak for a third time, faster - The Beatles, whose first three in 1964 took 15 weeks ('I Want To Hold Your Hand', 'I Saw Her Standing There' and 'Roll Over Beethoven / Hold Me Tight'), and Abba who took just 14 weeks in 1975/76 ('I Do, I Do, I Do, I Do, I Do', 'Mama Mia' and 'SOS'). Whilst The Beatles and Abba have it over Macklemore & Ryan Lewis in that they held the top of the chart exclusively through that time (the latter have only been on top for 12 of their 17 weeks), Macklemore & Ryan Lewis can claim the feat WITH THEIR FIRST THREE CHART SINGLES - so in that respect they are the fastest!

**#2: Passenger 'Let Her Go'** – this single first charted in March 2012 at No. 90 before leaving the top 100, then returned just three weeks ago at No. 56, in a spectacular ascent. This week it leaps 21 places!

**#4: MKTO 'Thank You'** – the duo's first top 5 single, and they hit Australian shores for a visit this week.

**#10: Calvin Harris featuring Ellie Goulding 'I Need Your Love'** – Calvin lands his fifth Australian top 10 single (sixth if you include his guest spot on Rihanna's No.2 2011 hit 'We Found Love'), with Ellie achieving her first - her recent single 'Anything Could Happen' peaked at No. 20.

**#12: Justin Timberlake 'Mirrors'** – this single leaps 14 spots as his previous top 10 single 'Suit & Tie' jumps back into the top 40 at No. 30.

**#24: Taylor Swift '22'** – makes a big improvement this week, up from 34 to 24.

### **Top 40 single debuts:**

#16: Little Mix 'Change Your Life' – the girls' second top 20 hit in Australia

#31: Flo Rida featuring Jennifer Lopez 'Sweet Spot' – the eighth single lifted from Flo Rida's 'Wild Ones' album

### **Albums**

#1: **Justin Timberlake 'The 20/20 Experience' (debut)** - Justin reaches the top of the ARIA Album Chart for a second time. His other chart topper landed in September 2006 when he spent a week on top with 'Future Sex / Love Sounds'.

This week marks the sixth in a row that we've had an album debut at #1 and the ninth in a row that we've had a different album at the summit. The last time we had as many as six No.1 debuts in a row was March /April 2011 (Avril Lavigne | Glee Cast | The Strokes | Britney Spears | Dapft | Foo Fighters).

#7: **Bruce Springsteen 'Collection: 1973 – 2012'** – with his Australian tour in full swing, this is the sixteenth ARIA top 10 album for Bruce, his most recent being 'Wrecking Ball' which debuted at No.2 a year ago. 'Wrecking Ball' returns to the top 40 at No. 16 this week.

#9: **Passenger 'All The Little Lights'** – A 10 place jump brings this UK act into the top 10 for the first time.

#24: **Rodriguez 'Searching For Sugarman' (debut)** - Rodriguez has charted four times in Australia and each of the albums has peaked between No.23 and No.28. Rising emphatically from No.49 last week, this may be the one to break into the top 20 ...

#30: **Rodriguez 'Cold Fact'** – this album originally peaked at No.23 in 1978, and is enjoying a resurgence as Rodriguez's tours across Australia.

### **Further top 40 album debuts:**

33. Laura Mvula 'Sing To The Moon' – debut album for this UK singer

34. Bob Evans 'Familiar Stranger' - fourth solo album for the Jebediah front man becomes his third top 40 album following 'Suburban Songbook' (No.15 June 2006) and 'Goodnight, Bull Creek' (No.22 April 2009).
